

Introduction

In space, you have to be clever to outsmart your opponent. In chess, there's an unusual chess capture called En Passant that can help you do just that!

Step 1 How Pawns Move

We know that pawns can move one or two spaces forward on their first move.



Step 2 Setting Up En Passant

In this example, the black pawn moved two spaces on its first move and landed right next to the white pawn. White can now capture black's pawn 'En Passant'

the white pawn. White can black's pawn 'En Passant'

Step 3 Making the En Passant Move

To capture En Passant, white moves the pawn diagonally to where the black pawn would be if it had only moved one space.
